- Nine full-time staff.
- Run by IE Domain Registry. Part of UCD-CS.

Introduction to .ie II

- Who can get a name, and what names can be given are controlled by policies:
- Connection with Ireland.
- Have a recognised claim on the name.
- Documentary evidence.
- Working DNS.

Recent Changes

- More than one domain on the basis of a corporate name.
- Electronic voting for proposed changes.
- True 'first past the post' behaviour.

Upcoming Changes

- Generic names.
- Holders of Irish trade mark.
- Applicants from Northern Ireland.

Upcoming Changes II

- 'Friendlier' personal names.
- Proof by assertion.
- Separation from UCD.
